Congenital Anomaly Register

ISOLATED SOFT MARKERS ON ULTRASOUND

Isolated soft markers on the 20 week scan can be ignored. However, if 2 or more are present *REPORT* to the register.

- ◆ Dilated renal pelves 5-10 mms (N28.8 U/B)
- ◆ Choroid plexus cysts (G93.0 M)
- ◆ Echogenic foci/golf balls (R93.10)
- ◆ Nuchal pad thickening (R93.01)
- ◆ Sandal gap (Q66.82)
- ◆ 2 Vessel cord (Q27.0)

The following should be included whether found in isolation or in combination:-

- ◆ Dilated renal pelves >10 mms at any gestation (N28.8 U/B)
- ◆ Dilated renal pelves > 8mm in the third trimester (N28.8 U/B)
- ◆ Cystic hygroma (D18.10)
- ◆ Nuchal pad thickening \geq 6 mm (R93.01)
- ◆ Echogenic bowel (should be = to echogenicity of adjacent bone) (R93.30)
- ◆ Short femur < 3rd centile (Q72.4)
